Ownership

1. Please supply a duly dated and signed copy of Trent Radio's by-laws

Programming

2. In Section 3.1 – Language(s) of Programming, you indicate that you will not be broadcasting during 3 periods of the year. Please provide details as to when those periods will be.
3. In Section 3.7 - Condition of Licence, you answer that you will not adhere to all conditions of licence stipulated in Public Notice CRTC 2000-156. Please specify which one of the conditions of licence you will not adhere to and a rationale for this exclusion.
4. The definition of a Campus station as set in Public Notice CRTC 2000-12 is a station owned or controlled by a not-for-profit organization associated with a post-secondary educational institution. Given that you indicate that you are a “student-sponsored independent corporation”, please clarify the role or relationship of Trent University with CFFF-FM?
5. As part of your renewal application, please confirm your adherence by condition of licence, to the 12% weekly minimum with respect to the
