## TRENT RADIO - CFFF 92.7FM Peterborough, Ontario (herein referred to as "the station")

-and-

National Campus and Community Radio Association/l'association nationale des radios étudiantes et communautaires (herein referred to as "NCRA/ANREC")

For the period February 19, 2015 to March 22, 2015.

1) All materials or projects developed in the name of the Rendez-vous de la Francophonie project become the property of the producer(s), the station and the NCRA/ANREC and can be freely disseminated to other c/c radio stations and the public.

The station will report on their work to NCRA/ANREC staff.

2) Remuneration and service expectations

i) The station is expected to recruit and train at least one producer to research and produce 17 original two-minute audio capsules on the theme of Canada's place in the Francophonie, the importance of French language and culture in Canada, local Francophone culture and special events during the Rendez-vous de la Francophone celebrations, as previously pitched and approved.

ii) The station will play an original audio capsule each day from March 6-March 22, five times per day.

iii) The station will be paid \$1000 for the recruitment and training of the producer(s), including any travel, studio, or equipment expenses and any related promotional expenses. The producer(s) will be paid at least \$500 for their work.

iv) The station will send mp3s of the audio capsules as produced to be featured on the NCRA/ANREC website.

v) The NCRA/ANREC will pay the station \$1500 upon submission of all 17 original audio capsules and either proof of play or signed confirmation from an authorized station representative that the station broadcast the 17 audio capsules five times a day for 17 days. The station is responsible to pay the producer(s). All work must be completed by agreed-upon deadlines.
